Guidelines for Project Work in Environmental Education

(HS 1st Year, 2026-27)

In accordance with the Assam State School Education Board (ASSEB), Division-II syllabus, *Environmental Education* is a compulsory subject for HS 1st Year students of all streams. The subject carries **50 marks** (40 marks written examination + 10 marks project work). The project component is compulsory and will be internally assessed.

All concerned **students and teaching staff** are hereby notified of the following guidelines for conducting and evaluating the project work:

For Students

- **Topic Selection:** Choose one project topic from the prescribed list (e.g., local environmental resource survey, pollution study, biodiversity observation, disaster management, road safety awareness, eco-club activities).
- **Length:** Maximum 1000 words, neatly handwritten or typed on A4 sheets, filed/spiral bound.
- **Structure:**
 - Cover page with Name, Roll No. (AHSEC), Class & Section.
 - Include pictures, data, or diagrams with captions.
 - Acknowledge all sources (web links, journals, reports, verbal/visual references).
- **Examples of Projects:**
 - Collect data by visiting a river/forest/agricultural land.
 - Prepare a note on pollution in a city/village/industrial area.

- Observe a nearby plant/insect/bird for three months and record changes.
- Prepare a first-aid box for disaster use.
- Create a pictorial table of mandatory/alarming road symbols.
- Form an eco-club and celebrate *World Environment Day* or *Road Safety Week*.
- **Submission Deadline:** Projects must be submitted by the **last week of December 2026** to the subject teacher.

For Teaching Staff

- **Facilitation:** Guide students in topic selection, research, and presentation.
- **Evaluation:** Assess projects based on descriptors such as understanding, research, originality, communication, creativity, and presentation.
- **Supervision:** Ensure projects are completed within the stipulated time and maintain academic honesty.
- **Integration:** Encourage students to link project findings with classroom learning and community awareness programs.

Important Notes

- Project work is **mandatory**; non-completion will result in *INCOMPLETE* status in the final result.
- Staff are requested to maintain proper records of project evaluation for submission to the Examination Committee.
- Students are encouraged to undertake projects that promote **environmental awareness, disaster preparedness, and road safety consciousness** in their community.
